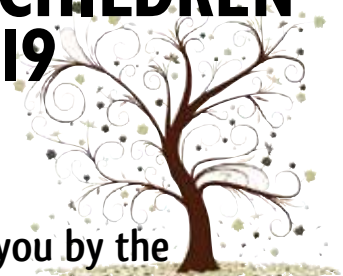

with Antonia (Toni) Szymanski, Ph.D.

Antonia (Toni) Szymanski is an Associate Professor of Gifted Studies at Western Kentucky University. Dr. Szymanski has published several articles on the needs of gifted students and how teachers can improve the educational experience of these learners. Her work focuses on underrepresented advanced students, the psychological and social needs of these learners, creativity, and talent development. She is on the editorial board for the NAGC publication Teaching for High Potential and is the NAGC Education and Research Network Program Chair. In addition to her professional work, Toni is the mom to two gifted children. She has experienced every type of educational setting from homeschool, private, religious, and public school with her children
